

Year Two: Number - Number and Place Value

- I can count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 * from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward
- I can read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and words.
- I can recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones)

Number - Addition and Subtraction


- I can recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100
- add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally, including:
a two-digit number and ones / a two-digit number and tens / two two-digit numbers/ adding three and one-digit number

Number - Multiplication and Division

- recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers

Number - Fractions

- recognise, find, name and write fractions $1/3$, $1/4$, $2/4$, and $3/4$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity

Writing

- *I can write about real events, recording them simply and clearly.*
- *I can demarcate my sentences with capital letters and full stops or question marks.*
